1. The threat of disease robs us of physical comfort and health (Luke 8:41-43; Exodus 15:26; Psalm 103:3).
2. The threat of despair steals our joy (Luke 8:43; Psalm 68:5; Psalm 103:13-15).
3. The threat of being destitute shakes our security (Luke 8:43; Matthew 6:31-33).

4. The threat of disconnection leaves us feeling devalued (Luke 8:47-48; Proverbs 3:12; Isaiah 64:8).

5. The ultimate threat of death strips us down to our mere mortality and helplessness (Luke 8:49-56; Deuteronomy 32:6; John 1:4, 12-14; Deuteronomy 1:31).

6. Application: In Jesus Christ, we do not fear death, nor the many forces of evil that assault us in this life.
