"Worth the Risk"

John 17:18-23

Humanity holds these three in common:

- 1. ALL- (are made in God's image)
- 2. ALL- (have fallen short of the glory of God).
- 3. ALL- (are invited to receive and participate in the life, forgiveness and fellowship found in Jesus Christ).

The church is not called to be safe from the world, but has been sent into the world. (John 17:18)

Barriers to living as those sent-

One's who are sent have:

Someone they <u>know</u>- You can only freely give what you have. May they also be in us so that the world may know you have sent us.

Something to show- **Unity of love testifies to the one who saved all.** Your quality of <u>love</u> is your greatest witness to "all" (John 13:34).

Something to share-

• Verbally clarifying the purpose of your love and life is the greatest <u>risk</u> you can take.

"Sent ones" are called to trust in Christ's <u>promise</u> and take <u>everyday</u> risks.

- When have you seen the Spirit unleashed in your own life?
- Where might you take a tangible risk and "jump in" to show and share Christ's love?
