“Kindness involves doing something deemed positive by the recipient.” (**BELIEVE**, p. 435)

“Goodness, however, sometimes entails tough love for the benefit of another because it will genuinely help them.” (**BELIEVE**, p. 435)

1) Goodness replaces selfishness with practical care for others (Acts 4:36-37).

2) Goodness replaces unbelief with expectant, observant faith (Acts 11:23-24).

3) Goodness replaces our need to be the center of attention with the desire to promote others' gifts and opportunities (Acts 11:25-26).

4) Goodness replaces indifference with involvement (Acts 11:27-30).

5) APPLICATION: (**BELIEVE** material): I choose to be kind and good in my relationships with others.
