Dearest Trinity Family,

I greet you with a heavy but hopeful heart as I affirm the grace, mercy, and peace of our Living Lord in these turbulent times.

The senseless death of George Floyd and so many others in the headlines has sparked the dry kindling of anger, setting ablaze overwhelming protests. The turmoil has left all of us reeling. This conflict added to the COVID-19 crisis is almost more than we can handle. What in the world do we do? Or, as followers of Jesus Christ, what in the Kingdom do we do?

Candidly, there are no “pat answers.” There are no simple solutions. This I do know: Jesus’ followers can make a difference, beginning with our everyday lives. The generational legacy of racism and injustice looks totally intimidating. But the starting point is to examine our own hearts.

Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me and lead me in the way everlasting (Psalm 139:23-24).

We allow the Lord to expose our own sin, empower us to repent, and then enable us to live out the gospel of reconciliation, as Jesus’ ambassadors. Then we exercise our influence where and when we can. That can begin in the long line at the store, the crowded parking lot, and the everyday interaction. May the Lord guide and direct us in our efforts as individuals and as a congregation.

1. Familiarize yourself with the CDC guidelines regarding COVID-19 ([cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/prevent-getting-sick/prevention](https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/prevent-getting-sick/prevention))

4. While transitioning from one location to another on campus, cloth face coverings are required.
