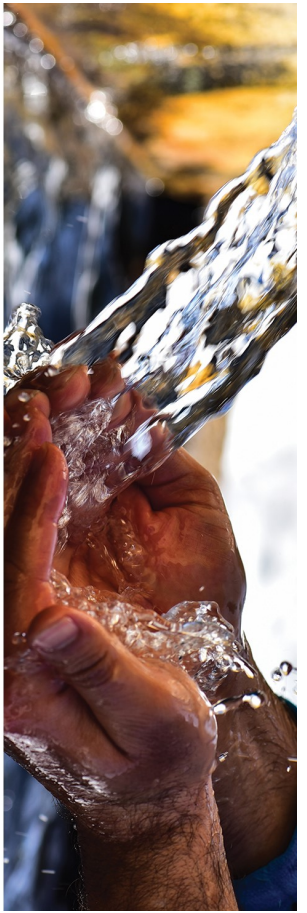

## John 4:1-5

Now Jesus learned that the Pharisees had heard that he was gaining and baptizing more disciples than John—2 although in fact it was not Jesus who baptized, but his disciples: 3 So Jesus left Judea and went back once more to Galilee.

4 Now he had to go through Samaria.
