OVERVIEW: Interns at Trinity are called to serve in Christian ministry for a summer as a way to glorify God, grow in faith, develop skills, gain work experience, and impact children. Interns play an important part in the lives of some amazing children through camp, summer programs, and Sunday School. It is extremely challenging and outrageously fun at the same time!

Intern job descriptions for 2024:

1. Program Intern Team (camps, weekday program)

Program Interns will assume a vital role in planning and implementing programs, supervising camp counselors and student volunteers (SCMT and JSCMT), and leading training events. This is a high energy staff position that will encompass the entire months of June and July, together with some intern training and prep work in late May. Program interns will serve in a supportive role on Sunday mornings.

2. Sunday Morning Ministry Intern Team (9:00am and 10:40am)

The Sunday Morning Ministry Intern Team will be responsible for all aspects of our Sunday morning outreach, including Super Sundays for elementary students, children's lessons, Second Hour Sunday School, and support for our Early Childhood program. If you are considering a career in children's ministry or education, this internship will give you a wide variety of practical experiences, from planning lessons to recruiting and equipping high school volunteers. Super Sundays run June 2 through August 4. Sunday Morning Interns will serve in a support role at select summer programs per the discretion of the Director of Children's Ministries.
